TH 104	Submission & Authority	Understanding obedience, submission and authority to become a powerful leader under the Lord's authority.
TH 105	The Character of a Leader	Developing the character of a leader and understanding that talent is never enough.
TH 106	Motivation of a Leader	Focusing on a successful today that counts towards all eternity.
TH 107	Evangelism	Evangelism as a presented through the kingdom's commission and the principles for effective evangelism through personal and mass evangelistic crusades.
TH 108	God's Generals	Discovering the history of the men and women in God's service that brought about Pentecostal revival.

BI 203	Hebrews	A study of the revelation of the present-day ministry of Christ, the High Priest and Mediator of the New Covenant.
TH 203	Old Testament Survey I	A brief overview of the books of Genesis through Esther from the Old Testament. Part 1.
TH 204	Old Testament Survey II	A brief overview of the books of Job through Malachi from the Old Testament. Part 2.

BI	204	Acts of the Apostles	A study of the Holy Spirit and His role in the Church as He guides the believer into the reality of the substitutionary sacrifice of the seated Christ.
TH	205	Christology	An in-depth consideration of the life of Christ; His divinity/deity, incarnation (the virgin birth), His humanity and ministry on earth through the Gospels.
TH	206	Dealing with Offenses	Exposing one of the most deceptive snares that takes believers out of God's will.
TH	301	Divine Healing	Developing an understanding of healing to the whole man, body soul and spirit and the provision by God in the Holy Scriptures.
TH	302	Gifts of the Holy Spirit	A general study of the gifts of the Holy Spirit and supernatural manifestations, miracles and the working of miracles.
TH	303	The Anointing	Understanding and identifying the anointing from God in the life of Jesus and for the believer today and flowing in the anointing of the Holy Spirit.
TH	304	Principles of Faith	Understanding the principles of faith, what it is, and how to develop it and use it to move mountains.
TH	305	New Creation Realities	A study in the revelation of Jesus to Paul concerning believers who are in Christ; their abilities, possessions and positions
TH	306	Authority of the Believer	Understanding the authority God has given the believer and its accompanying responsibility.
TH	307	Biblical Prosperity	Economics according to God's laws governing principles of giving, sowing and reaping, and financial purpose.
TH	308	The Fear of the Lord	Understanding the fear of the Lord that builds passions and intimacy with God in order for Christians to grow deeper in their relationship with Him
TH	309	Principles of Prayer	A comprehensive study of prayer and the development of a powerful prayer life through the Word of God.
MI	401	Battlefield of the Mind	A study on the spirit realm and the believer's victory according to scriptures.
TH	401	Angelology	A study of angels - their creation by God, their work and ministry; rank and titles; their role in the life of a believer, in warfare and evangelism.
MI	402	The Person of the Holy Spirit	Knowing the Person of the Holy Spirit in order to know how to flow with the Holy Spirit.
TH	402	Advance Bible Study	A study that will take you deeper into the spirit-filled walk of the believer.

MI	404	Homiletics	Spiritual dynamics of preparation, practical techniques, presentation and delivery of sermons.
TH	404	Plan of Redemption	From Genesis to Revelation, understanding the link of the scarlet thread throughout the bible.
MI	405	Introduction to Christian Counseling	Defining and understanding Christian counseling, its characteristics and application through the Bible.
TH	405	The Human Spirit	A study of the recreated human spirit.
MI	406	Christian Counseling I	Spiritual issues in Christian Counseling. To understand biblical-based, Spirit-anointed counseling as taught by Jesus.
TH	406	Covenants	A study on bible covenants and their meaning.
MI	407	Christian Counseling II	Spiritual issues in Christian Counseling. To understand biblical-based, Spirit-anointed counseling as taught by Jesus. Requirements: Must have completed Introduction to Christian Counseling and Christian Counseling I.
TH	407	Eschatology	The study of end times.
TH	408	Tabernacles of God	A study of the tabernacles of God, its message to the believer as set in the foundation and through types and shadows understanding the aspect of the person and work of Jesus.
MI	408	Worship	Living a life-style of worship and understanding its power and impact while being in the presence of the Lord.
TH	409	Ecclesiology I	The doctrine of the Church and its position as a God-ordained institution. The role of the 5-fold ministry and the government of the Church. Part 1.
TH	409	Ecclesiology II	The doctrine of the Church and its position as a God-ordained institution. The role of the 5-fold ministry and the government of the Church. Part 2.
MI	409	Ministerial Ethics & Church Administration	Ministry ethics and formalities. How to design and implement an effective administrative structure for any church; compliance with IRS regulations, and accountability principles.
TH	410	Understanding Theology	A study examining the essential truths of Christian Faith.
